Whatever the terrain, the MINI John Cooper Works Countryman never slows up. The model is more than a match for any surface, delivering control, response and power, along with exceptional torque and ALL4 all-wheel drive as standard. The vehicle also features the overboost function, temporarily providing up to 300 Nm of torque, in the unlikely event that you need a little extra kick. And even with this power at its disposal, the 218 hp/160 kW¹ engine is particularly economical when it comes to fuel consumption.

The MINI John Cooper Works Paceman never fails to make an impression. Its unique design, both outside and in, effortlessly bridges the gap between urban chic and racing pedigree. The Sports Activity Coupé packs in 218 hp/160 kW¹, which is given full expression through the impressive tailpipes of the sports exhaust system. The high-tech engine incorporates direct fuel injection, variable valve control and a twin-scroll turbocharger, and offers up to 300 Nm of torque thanks to the overboost function. This incredible power is harnessed in full by the ALL4 variable all-wheel drive system fitted as standard. The technology catapults the vehicle to 100 km/h in just 6.8 seconds, and ensures the MINI John Cooper Works Paceman has everything necessary to tackle any challenge the city streets may throw at it.

With a top speed of 240 km/h however, admirers have to move fast if they want to take in its stylish design. The performance delivered by the 211 hp/155 kW engine¹ with overboost function, which temporarily pushes the torque from 260 to 280 Nm, is enough to satisfy even the most demanding MINI driver. In combination with the direct steering and stiff suspension set-up, the unit ensures the automatically deploying rear spoiler is just about all onlookers will see of the vehicle.
