The BMW X6 M effortlessly overturns conventional thinking when it comes to high-performance four-wheel-drive vehicles in its class. Its breathtaking M design makes that clear from the word go. Features include standard 20" light alloy wheels, large air intakes, two Chrome twin tailpipes, M-typical gills, side sills and bumpers in body colour, as well as exclusive M paint choices such as metallic Melbourne Red. The combined effect is enough to set the pulse racing even when the vehicle's at a standstill. A host of design elements also underline the distinctive, Coupé-like character of the BMW X6 M. Its dynamic wedge shape, steeply raked front windscreen, flared wheel arches and sloping roofline create a look that embodies athleticism, power and exceptional acceleration.



M VALUES SET STANDARDS BEYOND COMPARE.

It is one of the most coveted car badges of all: the M logo. Every vehicle that carries it represents a pure expression of our values: seemingly never-ending acceleration across the entire rev range, thrilling agility and peerless tracking stability through every bend. These typical M attributes have now conquered a further segment. Each component of the BMW X5 M and the BMW X6 M relevant to driving dynamics – such as xDrive four-wheel-drive or Dynamic Performance Control – has been specifically M tuned. Others, such as the M TwinPower Turbo engine, are all-new developments. The result: M now sets the benchmark in this class too.

One of the most powerful statements ever made on the road, the BMW X5 M is an exclusive combination of flexibility and superior handling. The generous front apron, identical to that on the BMW X6 M, exudes a particularly imposing presence. But its purpose goes deeper: together with the Black kidney grille and three large air intakes, it enables optimal cooling of the engine and the high performance brake system. Flaps adapted from motorsport at the lower edge of the external air intakes improve handling at high speeds and lend the vehicle a low, sporty stance.

THE INTERIOR OF THE BMW X5 M EMANATES MOTORSPORT CHARACTER.

The spacious interior of the BMW X5 M accommodates up to five people in a stylish mix of space, comfort and typical M sportiness. This dynamic elegance is exemplified by exclusive fittings such as the combination of M interior trims in Black Carbon-structure leather and Silverstone full Merino leather upholstery (pictured here). There's also an optional panoramic glass sunroof that fills the interior with light, optional four-zone automatic air conditioning and a comprehensive

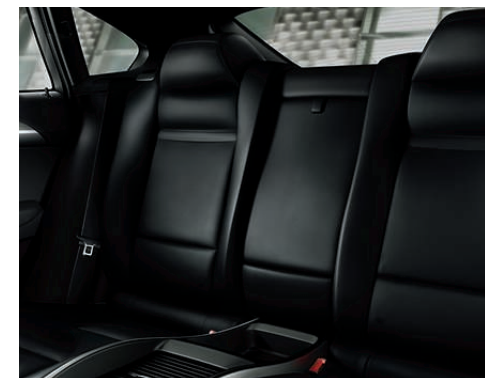
range of entertainment systems to enhance your driving pleasure. If desired, you can choose a BMW Individual audio system with 16 high-end speakers that will do full justice to the vehicle's high performance M principles. The BMW X5 M is accommodating in other ways, too. Its loading capacity, for instance, extends to 1,750 litres with the rear seats folded down so even bulky items can be easily stowed away.



A NEW VIEW OF HIGH PERFORMANCE.

Now you can experience M fascination from an entirely new perspective. The raised seating position in the BMW X5 M and the BMW X6 M gives a sense of total control and safety even at high speeds. When manoeuvring or parking, the optional Reversing Assist camera with Top view provides added assistance and the optional Side view cameras offer visual assistance when pulling out of junctions with restricted visibility. To ensure perfect ergonomics, the cockpit is tilted slightly towards the driver in typical BMW fashion and the latest-generation iDrive control system allows intuitive operation of many vehicle settings. The two

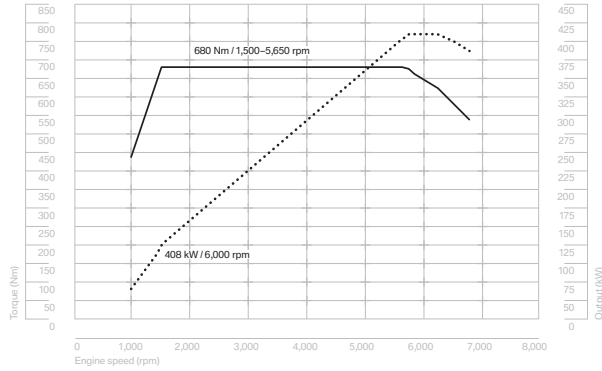
circular instrument dials come in typical M design and are similarly driver-focused. In conjunction with a variable maximum engine speed recommendation, they are easy to read and support the driver particularly during sporty driving. The M-specific Head-up Display further focuses attention by projecting all relevant data, including the rev counter and gear selection display, directly into the driver's line of sight. Yet, for all this purposeful dynamism, the elegant ambience remains, as you'll see with the leather dashboard, standard on the BMW X6 M and optional on the BMW X5 M.



The standard four-seat version has a large storage compartment with a sliding cover between the two individual rear seats.

THE CABIN OF THE BMW X6 M. AN M INTERIOR THAT WON'T LET YOU GO.

The BMW X6 M welcomes you with a sporty, exclusive interior that instantly feels tailor-made. Full-electric M Sport seats (standard) optimally adapt to your physique. Generous side support, even in the shoulder area, guarantees a secure hold during fast cornering. And the seats come in Merino leather upholstery as standard. In the rear of BMW X6 M, two individual seats add to the distinctive appeal while also underlining the car's sporty character with their integrated headrests and generous side supports. The optional comfort seats are particularly cossetting, while the 60:40 split-folding rear seat backrests, the roof lining designed for greater headroom in the rear and the optional through-loading ski bag all make the BMW X6 M a genuine all-round athlete. Finally, the luggage compartment offers ample space for up to four golf bags and opens and closes automatically at the push of a button.



Maximum torque is available across an extremely broad rev band, from 1,500 to 5,650rpm, creating rapid responsiveness not normally associated with a turbo engine. Traction is also consistently high, even in the upper rev ranges.



Like every BMW, the BMW X5 M and the BMW X6 M come with the BMW EfficientDynamics technology package as standard. With features such as High-precision direct injection, the new M TwinPower Turbo engine sets benchmarks in terms of its performance and fuel consumption ratio.

THE M TWINPOWER TURBO ENGINE.

In the BMW X5 M and the BMW X6 M the M-typical linear power curve meets the formidable thrust of Twin-turbo. This high performance V8 engine delivers maximum torque of 680Nm and an output of 555hp (408kW) to power both vehicles from 0 to 62mph (100km/h) in only 4.7 seconds. The M Sport automatic transmission plays a central

role, particularly in manual mode with its impressively quick shift times and the option of changing gears via the M gearshift paddles on the steering wheel. You can also choose between two different engine and transmission management modes. The "Efficient" mode gives you a more gentle engine response and earlier gear changes, which improves fuel

consumption. The "Sport" mode, on the other hand, is designed for maximum dynamics – the car accelerates even more powerfully, accompanied by a sound that gives you goosebumps every time you touch the pedal. Both driving modes are pre-programmed in the M Drive menu and can be called up via the M Drive button on the steering wheel.

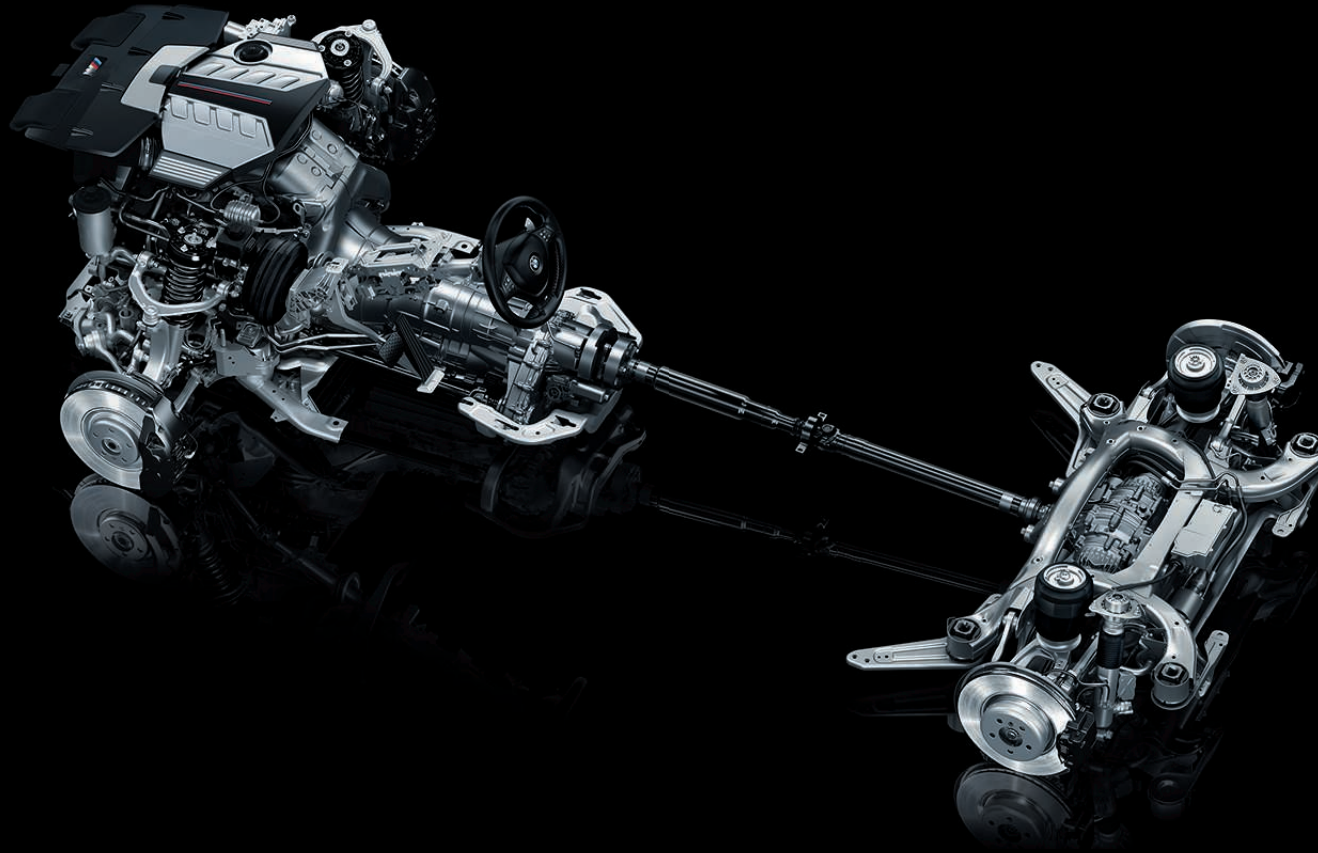


The M Drive function allows for individual configuration of key driving dynamics components such as the engine characteristics – from extremely sporty to comfort-oriented. The settings can be called up by pressing a button on the steering wheel.



Two highly efficient TwinScroll turbochargers form the basis of an astonishingly rapid response. A BMW-patented cross-bank exhaust manifold combines the exhaust flows from each of the cylinder pairs (illustration, far left). These are then routed into a channel in the snail-shell-like turbine housings (hence "scroll"), separate from the exhaust flows of the other cylinders, thus enabling them to reach the turbine wheel unimpeded and at high speed (illustration, left).

M-specific spring-damper tuning underpins driving stability and contributes to outstandingly neutral steering properties. Depending on the desired tuning mode – for enhanced long-distance comfort or dynamic driving, for instance – you can choose between the two damper settings Normal and Sport by pressing a button on the gear selector lever.



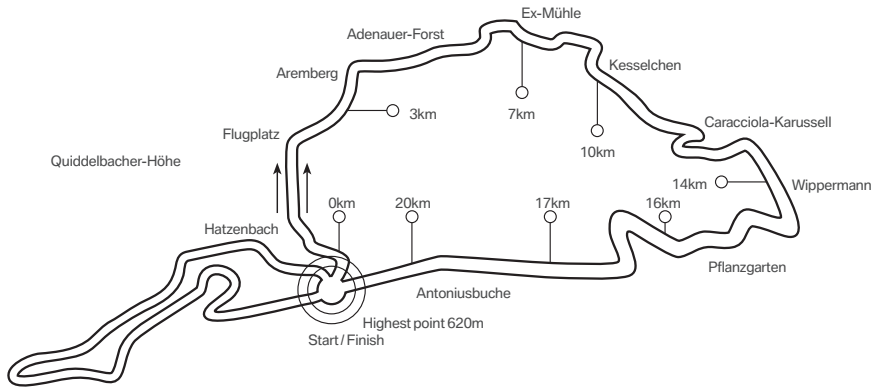
The lightweight high performance brake system is remarkable for its extremely short braking distances and high stability. Braking power can be finely applied and the system responds to brake commands with total precision. Even at high speeds the deceleration values are impressive.

M DYNAMICS TO THE FINEST DETAIL. THE PRECISION CHASSIS.

High levels of driving stability and agility are a given in BMW M models. But, considering their size, the fact that these values are seen in the BMW X5 M and BMW X6 M almost defies belief. It's all down to the intelligent interplay of specifically M-tuned chassis technologies. This allows for unrivalled driving dynamics, controlled with precision and safety even at the physical limit. The BMW X5 M and BMW X6 M are the first M models ever to feature the xDrive intelligent four wheel-drive system. This distributes drive power flexibly between the front and rear axle to ensure the greatest possible traction and directional stability. A sporty driving style is also supported in both models by Dynamic Performance Control with M specific settings, fitted as standard.

This optimally divides torque between the rear wheels depending on the driving situation. It means that, particularly during cornering, more power is transferred to the road and handling and tracking stability are further enhanced. One of the most astonishing driving characteristics when you consider the dimensions of these vehicles is that each can handle fast cornering and sudden braking or acceleration with virtually no movement of the car body. This is thanks to the chassis control system Adaptive Drive, with its combination of roll stabilisation and Electronic Damper Control (EDC). With its M-specific tuning – which lowers the chassis by 10mm – Adaptive Drive allows for unrivalled steering precision and tracking stability. As the load alteration effect is palpably reduced,

Adaptive Drive noticeably increases ride comfort and safety, too. You can also adjust numerous settings individually – for example, damper control via the EDC button on the gear lever and stability control via a switch in the centre console. In addition, the M Drive button on the steering wheel allows you to call up pre-programmed vehicle configurations which support either very sporty or more comfortable driving. One of them is M Dynamic mode. This allows for maximum lateral and longitudinal dynamics of the vehicle. Here, the control functions of Dynamic Stability Control (DSC) are significantly delayed and will only intervene to stabilise the car in critical situations.



CAN BE SEEN ON CITY STREETS. BUT HOME IS ON THE RACE TRACK.

In 1978, the first BMW M model became the fastest German road sports car – the legendary M1. It established what would become the BMW M philosophy of combining race track and everyday driving at the highest level, from high performance drivetrains to the tiniest

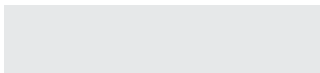
interior details. These are more than just words: valuable experiences from touring car racing and Formula One are fed directly into series production. Each BMW M is also developed and rigorously tested on race tracks, including the notorious Nürburgring

Nordschleife where the BMW X5 M and the BMW X6 M were honed to perfection. It's how fascinating automobiles for motorsport enthusiasts have been created for more than three decades.

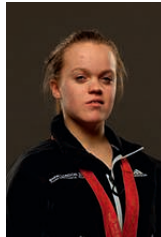
MARK HUNTER Rowing
