

The Peugeot *206 cc*





The 206 CC epitomises an exciting concept – the creation of two cars in one without compromising on style or safety. It's a car that's been designed with foresight and vision, yet still maintains the tradition of the 206 philosophy.

100 % Coupé.

There is no denying what your eyes tell you. With the roof up, the 206 Coupé Cabriolet is exactly what it seems – an utterly distinctive and eye catching coupé with a lower profile, a higher boot line and a larger and more sharply raking windscreen to enhance its visual dynamism.

100 % Cabriolet.

This is a cabriolet that puts a roof over your head in seconds, offering all the weather protection and sound insulation of a coupé. Not one that billows at speed and could be prone to vandalism, or a removable hardtop with all its attendant storage problems and inherent limitations.

Restrained power, innovation and innate quality of design are the intrinsic attributes of the 206 CC. They are all combined in this avant-garde car to create a future classic.

So many elements are ahead of their time but this car also has the smooth lines and classic touches that recall the style of other legendary cabriolets. The sharply raked windscreen will surprise you with its sheer size, and you'll notice that the CC sits low on the ground – just like a coupé should.

With its high boot line, flowing contours and zinging colours, this is a car that possesses both a thrusting masculine profile and a seductive feminine side. Male and female; it couldn't be more 21st century.

•1 The 206 Coupé Cabriolet has been ingeniously designed with 'A' pillars whose elegance belies their immense structural strength and elegantly curved front windows and quarter lights to reduce wind and noise.

•2 In the very finest traditions of 2 + 2 motoring, safety roll arches protect the rear passengers in the event of an accident.

•3 As in classic cabriolets of the past, the boot of the 206 Coupé Cabriolet features striking design flourishes.



•4 You will find quality everywhere you look, like the polished aluminum doorsills on the 2.0 SE model.

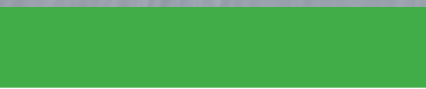

Inside and out, whichever way you look at the 206 CC, you'll see a careful balance of ambient style and uncompromising attitude that emphasises the dual image of the car. It's a sporty, wind in the hair convertible. Then, at the touch of a button, it's a genuine coupé with interior space that still gives you room to breathe.

The sports front seats provide body-hugging support and a comfortable driving position, and blend perfectly with the inspired fabric trim choices. You could have Mirage Blue, Citrus Green, Pebble Grey or Sunset Orange. Or perhaps you prefer the extra cost option of cool leather upholstery - Astrakan Black or two-tone Salsa Red/Astrakan Black.



This sensational Coupé Cabriolet is available with a high technology 2.0 litre petrol engine which generates impressive power with all the economy* you expect from Peugeot, producing a phenomenal 138 bhp. It also provides the 206 Coupé Cabriolet with a performance* that more than justifies its classic good looks – scintillating acceleration, effortless overtaking and a top speed of 126 mph (where legal). The 1.6 litre engine produces 110 bhp, a top speed of 120 mph (where legal) and is available with the option of automatic transmission. Whichever version you choose, you can look forward to enjoying dynamic performance and exhilarating ride and handling in the most beautiful and distinctive car on the road.

The design of the 206 CC was inspired by the challenge of combining safety with pleasure. The height of the seat belt, for example, is more than just a stylistic whim; together with the lowered seat, it gives you extra protection. It's just one of the features that puts the 206 CC at the cutting edge of active and passive safety.

There's also a sophisticated braking system, including ABS with Electronic Brake Force Distribution (EBFD), Emergency Brake Assist (EBA) and Electronic Stability Programme (ESP)*. These safety features combine to give you a level of comfort that ensures worry-free driving.

ABS reduces the risk of the wheels locking on slippery surfaces and significantly reduces braking distances.

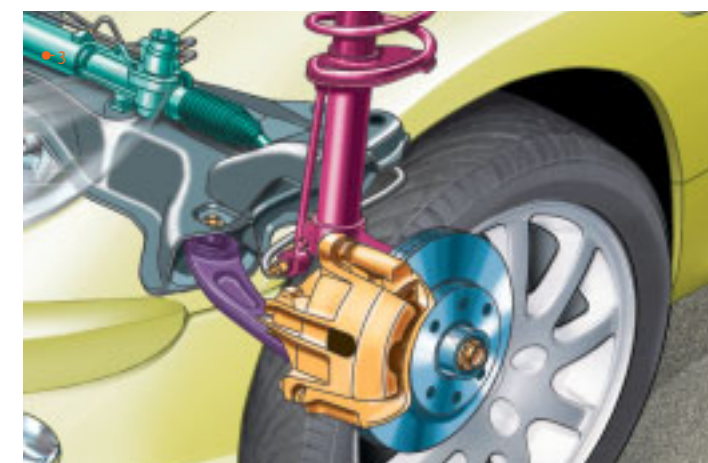
EBA assists with rapid braking and emergency stopping. It works together with ABS when you brake hard to amplify the braking pressure.

ESP* combines four functions:
 Electronic Brake Force Distribution (EBFD) distributes braking pressure on all four wheels to improve vehicle control.
 Anti-lock Brakes (ABS)
 Traction Control (ASR) stops the wheels spinning.
 Dynamic Stability Control (DSC) helps you bring the car back on the right track.

The SMART twin front airbags mean that their inflation pressure and speed are adjusted depending on the level of impact. There's also a brightness sensor which automatically turns your headlights on when it gets dark** and your hazard warning lights come on with the Emergency Brake Assist.

The 206 Coupé Cabriolet is in a class of its own. It's two terrific cars in one. It's a stylish and distinctive cabriolet which can be turned into a striking coupé in a matter of seconds, and it's a beautiful coupé with a retractable roof which automatically opens up to the great outdoors at the touch of a button. The Peugeot 206 Coupé Cabriolet is not only a breakthrough in terms of design and the fusion of form and function, it is also a supreme example of the very finest, innovative engineering. The roof of the 206 Coupé Cabriolet is just one tangible example of Peugeot's engineering edge.

Practical – The roof is automatically operated simply by pressing a button – that's all. When raised, all the driver needs to do is secure the roof in place with two locking clips.

Durability – The 206 Coupé Cabriolet is impervious to all kinds of weather. In tests, it has been subjected to simulated storms and accelerated corrosion, and the roof opened and closed more than 10,000 times (that's many more times than you ever will). Just as you'd expect, it passed.



Closing
The windows are lowered (if they are in the raised position). The boot cover lifts and tilts to the rear. The roof extends and closes over the passenger compartment. The boot cover closes.

Opening
The side windows and quarter lights are simultaneously lowered. The boot cover lifts and tilts to the rear. The roof folds into two sections and slides down into the boot. The boot cover closes.

• **1 Cabriolet configuration**
With the roof folded, the boot still has a capacity of around 200 litres. A protective rear boot shelf pulls out to enable the roof to fold away and built-in safety features ensure that the roof cannot be raised accidentally.

• **2 Coupé configuration**
In coupé mode the rear boot shelf is retracted leaving a boot with a generous 400-litre capacity – about the same as a compact hatchback.



Intelligent equipment. The Peugeot 206 Coupé Cabriolet bristles with technology with the primary objective of making driving as safe and delightful as it can be. More thought and more intelligence from Peugeot.



Sports pack is an extra cost option on 1.6 S, standard on 2.0 SE.

- The windscreen wipers come on automatically and adapt their speed to the intensity of the rain, while the automatic headlights come on in gloomy conditions or at dusk (depending on version).

- **Athermic** (heat reflective) windscreen is linked to the rain sensor and automatic headlights on.

- **Electric** front and rear windows are standard.



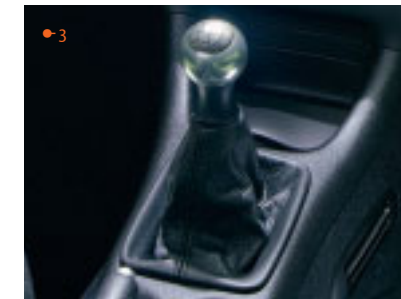
•-1 **Digital air conditioning with climate control** for control of the temperature and airflow. (On 2.0 SE model only – as standard)

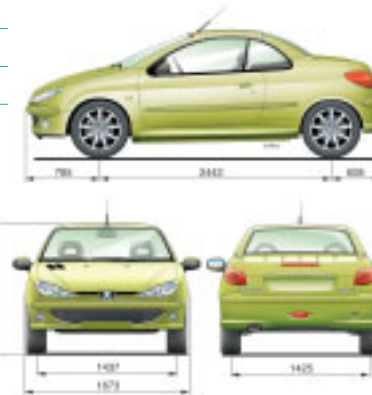

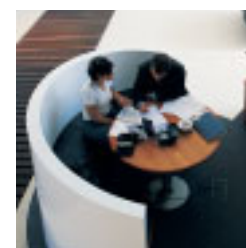
