When you own a Scirocco, it's more than just your car; it's part of you. Touch the gas pedal, and the engine responds instantly. So does the steering. "Response is immediate..." wrote *Car & Driver*. "The steering is so quick that you don't have to change your grip on the wheel for most turns."

The Scirocco's body is a natural extension of yours. Generous expanses of glass extend your vision. An electric rear-window defogger (standard equipment) improves your rear vision in bad weather.

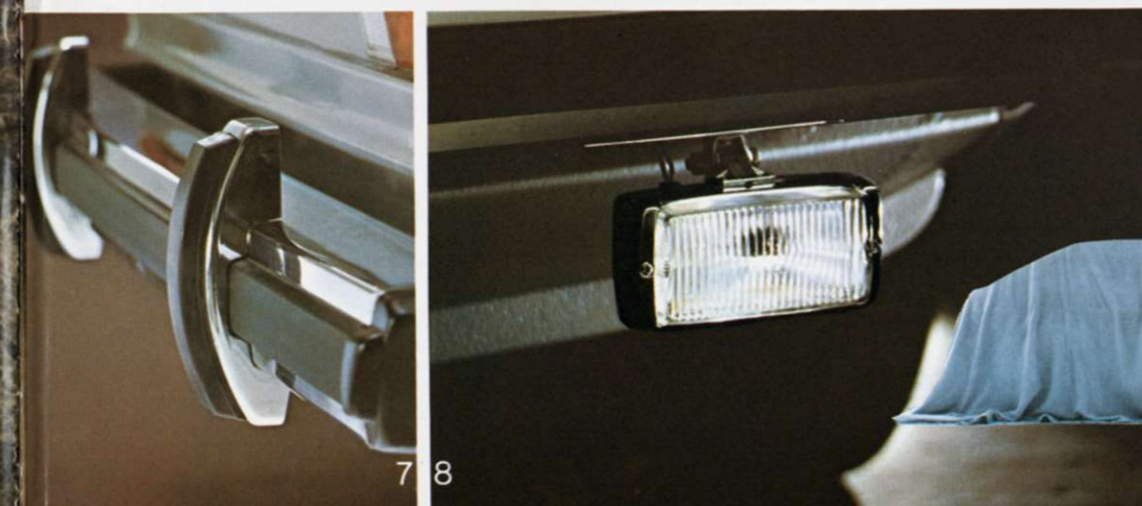
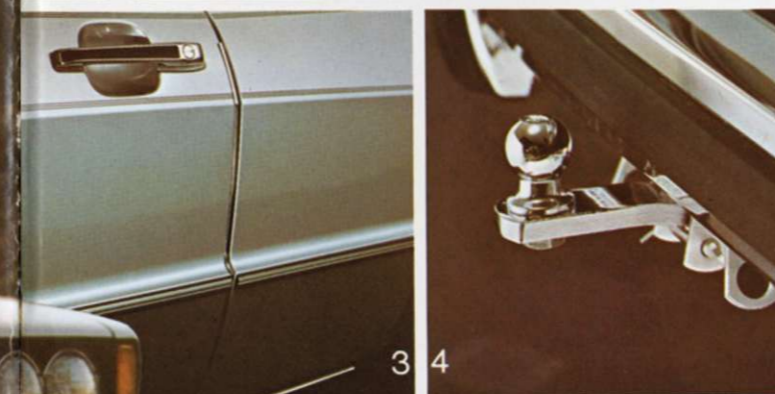
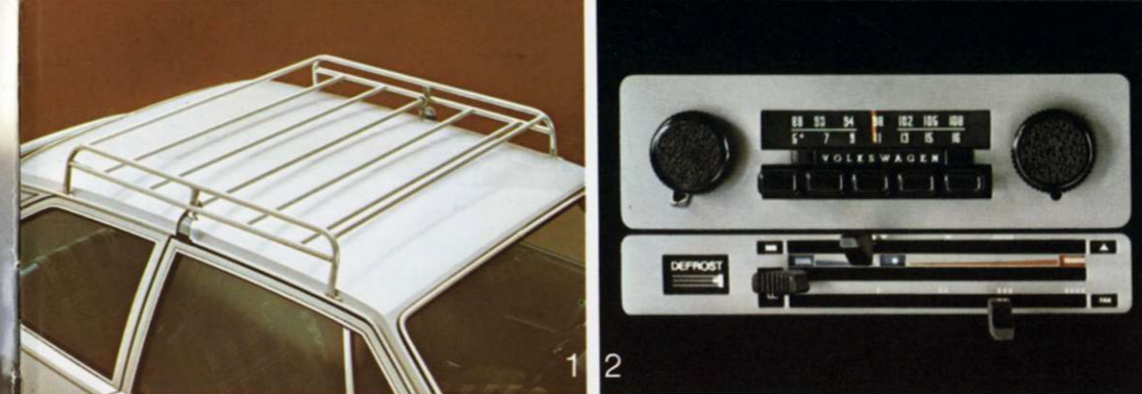
The contours of the seats are designed to fit those of your body. The racing-type steering wheel, shift lever, and other controls are exactly where your hands expect to find them.
